

## Export the VPN Client Security Policy File


1. Select **Export Security Policy** in the **File** menu at the top of the **Security Policy Editor** window. A window similar to the following will be displayed.



2. Click **Yes** to lock the Security Policy and prevent remote users from changing the VPN client policy. Click **No** to permit remote user configuration. Then name the security policy database file (\*.spd) and save it to a local folder or to a floppy disk.

## Import the VPN Client Security Policy File

1. Select **Import Security Policy** in the **File** menu at the top of the **Security Policy Editor** window.
2. Browse your local hard drive for the desired security policy database file (\*.spd) and click **Open**. A window similar to the following will be displayed.



3. Click **Yes** to save the security policy database file to the SonicWALL VPN Client.

## Uninstall the VPN Client

1. To uninstall the SonicWALL VPN Client, open the **Control Panel** in the Windows **Start** menu.
2. Double click **Add/Remove Programs** in the Control Panel window.
3. Select **SonicWALL VPN Client** in the Add/Remove Programs Properties window and click **Add/Remove**.
4. Click **Yes** in the Confirm File Deletion window to delete the VPN client and all of its components.
