Export the VPN Client Security Policy File

1. Select **Export Security Policy** in the **File** menu at the top of the **Security Policy Editor** window. A window similar to the following will be displayed.



2. Click **Yes** to lock the Security Policy and prevent remote users from changing the VPN client policy. Click **No** to permit remote user configuration. Then name the security policy database file (*.spd) and save it to a local folder or to a floppy disk.

Import the VPN Client Security Policy File

- 1. Select **Import Security Policy** in the **File** menu at the top of the **Security Policy Editor** window.
- 2. Browse your local hard drive for the desired security policy database file (*.spd) and click **Open**. A window similar to the following will be displayed.

- 1. To uninstall the SonicWALL VPN Client, open the **Control Panel** in the Windows **Start** menu.
- 2. Double click Add/Remove Programs in the Control Panel window.
- 3. Select **SonicWALL VPN Client** in the Add/Remove Programs Properties window and click **Add/Remove**.
- 4. Click **Yes** in the Confirm File Deletion window to delete the VPN client and all of its components.
